Excerpts from a devotional for the 1st Sunday of Advent Melissa McLean-Emanuel UCC, Warren

For a few years now Emanuel UCC has been involved in the Search and Call process, looking diligently for a new leader to guide our congregation. We have written profiles, done surveys, reviewed profiles, interviewed candidates and hopefully prayed. *We are still waiting*.

Some days we wait better than others. Some days it is easier than others. As I look back over all that has happened in this period of waiting and patience I see a past overflowing with gifts from God.... In this period of waiting, we have strengthened our bonds as a congregation and rediscov-

ered gifts both new and old.... Most importantly, with the grace of God, we have grown together as not only a church, but as a family, to carry on the mission and the work of the Church. We stand together waiting.

In this period of waiting we have been asked by God to trust, and hope, and believe in that which is to come. *Waiting is often hard work*.

Each and every day our God asks all of us to wait in patience and love, and with humility and grace. We are asked to trust in the divine. We are asked to stand together, trusting in each other. We wait expectantly for Christ.

As the coming of Christ approaches, we are reminded that to truly love one another is to love God. We are reminded that the twin gifts of patience and discovery are ours to enjoy over and over again...
