We are aware that there is a diaper emergency in Westmoreland County. The County Children’s Bureau is collecting diapers through the Mom’s Helping Mom’s program. Many families in our area who reside in poverty are unable to provide an adequate supply of diapers for their little ones. In addition to the health concerns it causes babies, it can also make it very difficult for a parent to work, as most daycares require that parents supply diapers. Diapers cannot be purchased with food stamps or WIC, putting them financially out of reach for our neediest families. Over the summer, we will be collecting diapers.
