
## Away for Father's Day

As we get ready for Father's Day this Sunday, millions of families will not be enjoying celebrations with their fathers. This Sunday 2.7 million children, and millions of adults, are attempting to stay connected with a father who is in prison, jail, or detention. They will be boarding buses, mailing crayon-drawn pictures, or facing the skyhigh cost of a 15-minute phone call.

Take action – express your solidarity with families facing incarceration.

Families face costs, sometimes as much as \$30 for 15 minutes, every week as they try to support their loved ones. Last year faith advocates successfully brought long distance rates down, but local calls still comprise 92% of all domestic calls from prison.

Matthew 25:35-40 teaches us, as people of faith, that we cannot forget those in prison. Families do not deserve to be punished.



This week's action is twofold:

- 1. Write a note of support directly to families facing incarceration, sharing your support with people who often bear their burden alone in isolation and shame. These messages will be shared with real families by our partners in the Healing Communities ministry.
- 2. By sending a letter you will also be added to a petition calling on the FCC to eliminate ALL predatory phone rates.
